

Summer Internship Opportunity

OVERVIEW:

Participate in the evaluation of **cover crops** and the role they play in cropping system sustainability, **soil health**, and weed management as a part of the **USDA-ARS Sustainable Agricultural Systems Laboratory** in **Beltsville, MD**.

Students will have opportunities to develop professional skills, such as: data management and entry; biomass harvesting and soil sampling, processing, and analysis; weed identification, and seedbank analysis; plant breeding, and greenhouse management.

Paid and unpaid internships are available, based on the applicant's experience with lab and/or field research. Applicants may be eligible for college credit.
